## Ecuadorian Sports AASSA Rules & Regulations

The curfew for all athletes is <u>10:00PM</u> and must be enforced by the parents. Students are NOT allowed out after the stated curfew time. The families should wait for a telephone call before, during, or after the curfew time. The Athletic Director will call to make sure that the students have complied with the curfew time. **They must answer the phone**. If the phone is not answered, this is considered the same as if the student is not at home.

\*If the student is asleep, the parent must wake them so that the AD can speak directly with them.

## **Student Conduct:**

Students will exercise good conduct during all Ecuadorian Sports AASSA events as **participants**, **spectators** and **guests** at the tournament venue. Students must know and abide by the following rules and regulations.

- 1. Negative attitudes and aggressiveness toward other players and officials will not be tolerated.
- 2. Athletes must attend all official organized tournament events, including opening and closing ceremonies.
- 3. When staying with a host family, the student's behavior must be respectful and considerate. The student is expected to show their appreciation to their hosts by giving a small gift.
- 4. Long distance phone calls should be kept to a minimum when staying with a host family, and should only be made with the permission of the host parents.
- 5. Changes in housing allocations should be requested only for very serious reasons and should be handled by the Athletic Director or the person in charge. This application should be submitted to the local Athletic Director or person in charge of housing.
- 6. In compliance with the Ecuadorian Sports AASSA guidelines, smoking, drinking alcohol, illegal drug use, cheating, deceit, and inappropriate sexual behavior are expressly prohibited at all times.
- 7. A curfew of 10:00PM will be strictly enforced.
- 8. Students are not allowed to attend clubs, bars or parties where alcohol is present.
- 9. All students must also adhere to the rules and regulations pre-established by their respective schools.

The host Athletic Director has the obligation to immediately report violations of these rules and regulations to the student's school Athletic Director.

## **Consequences:**

When a student commits any of the above infractions, any and all of the following consequences may be applied:

- a) The student will be suspended for a game.
- b) The student will no longer participate in the remainder of the tournament/event.
- c) The student will be sent home at his/her parent's expense if it is feasible to do so.
- d) The student will be banned from any AASSA Sports event for up to one calendar year. He/She will also be ineligible for any awards pertaining to AASSA Sports events.
- e) An athlete will be banned from the next AASSA event in which season he/she has been or will be participating in.
- f) An athlete will be required to complete up to 25 hours of community service. In the case of a senior, community service hours must be completed prior to graduation.
- g) Upon the return to school, appropriate counseling will be required. Students may also have additional penalties and recommendations consistent within their school policy.

I recognize that it is a privilege and not a right to participate in this exchange. I understand that if I do not follow this contract, there will be appropriate consequences according to my behavior.
